More General AuthN/Z Thoughts

What is most important? (and timing of priorities)
How can we build some depth in this [critical!] area?

- SURA/Dali to take on first level support, maybe operations...
- Differentiate between who can do what at current LoA and if this would stay the same if we went to higher LoA. In two-tiered PKI, different operations could result in different modes of maintenance.
- Only move to TAGPMA (or similar) level PKI when there is an application driver.
- Confirmed that the current next-level directions are sound even if we are not ready for higher LoA.
- Possible update of AuthN/Z paper for submission to NIST PKI 08. [Roadmap-ish?] Related: SGC Strategic Plan as a paper? Or paper on sustainability.
