Characteristic Definitions:

- Non-reassignable – the identifier value will never be assigned to another real-world subject (eg dce guid)
- Non-revocable – the real world subject will never have another value for this identifier (eg ssn)
- Opaque versus lucent – can the real world subject be discerned from the value of the identifier (eg email addresses are usually lucent; UUID’s and barcodes are opaque)
- Public visibility – who can see the identifier (eg email address)
